

SAA International UPDATE on COVID-19

As communities begin to feel the impact of the coronavirus (COVID-19).

The health and safety of every person who walks onto our campus continues to be a top priority. We are carefully monitoring the evolving COVID-19 (Corona virus) situation through local, state, national and international health authorities and will continue to take a proactive approach to keep our community healthy. While we are not currently making any changes to our office hours, we are taking the following extra precautions to mitigate risk.

Our housekeeping and sanitation efforts around our campus have been greatly expanded. We're frequently disinfecting often-touched surfaces such as door handles, countertops, keyboards, restroom surfaces, simulators, airplane controls and all our headsets. We're asking all of our staff (and we urge everyone) to follow the CDC guidelines to prevent the spread of the infection.

We feel deeply for those who have been affected. Thankfully, as of now, we're not aware of students or staff members contracting COVID-19. But we have implemented guidelines that instruct any student or staff member who may develop symptoms or come into contact with infected individuals to stay home and follow the CDC's instructions.

Prioritize your personal health

- Frequently washing your hands with soap and water
- Keeping surfaces clean
- Sneezing or coughing into a tissue or your elbow
- Most importantly, please stay home when you feel that you are sick with flu-like symptoms, including a fever of 100-degrees Fahrenheit or 38-degrees Celsius or higher, shortness of breath, and coughing
- Highly suggests canceling flights and classes if you are feeling ill.
